Objectives:


- To create awareness about COVID prevention measures in society.

- To sensitize people about social distancing

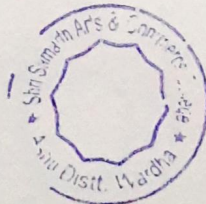
Outcomes :


- Thirty five students participated in the campaign.

The Covid -19 pandemic has spread throughout the nation since March 2020 .It has seriously affected public life in all places .As the time passed on ,the severity of the pandemic subsidized and the Govt. allowed activities in public places with many restrictions The Govt .of Maharashtra launched a programme titled as " **My Family – My Responsibility**" during **1 September to 5 November 2020** for creating awareness among people about COVID prevention measures.

The NSS unit of the college contributed to the mission and helped Govt. authorities to spread the message that every citizen should behave responsibly and also guide his family to follow rules of social distancing .The NSS volunteers regularly circulated the messages through digital posters, videos on whats app . Outcomes :

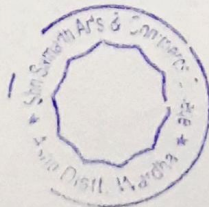
- 45 students and youth in Ashti donated blood in the camp

The nation is going through critical times due to spread of Covid -19 pandemic across all physical boundaries and abroad also. Scarcity of blood units in blood banks during this period created critical medical emergencies where people were left helpless. As a part of social obligation, the college has been constantly organizing blood donation camps in rural areas around Ashti every year . But the emergency in current conditions is obligatory.

The NSS unit organized a blood donation camp on 4 December 2020 in collaboration with Dr. Hedgewar Blood Bank .Nagpur, Red Ribbon Club and Nehru Youth Centre, Ashti. A small welcoming to Blood Bank team was arranged in the beginning .The college greeted the technicians' team. Mr. Pravin Patil from the Blood Bank explained the students about eligibility of donors and benefits of blood donation. He added that blood donation is our social obligation and we should fulfill it.

Total 45 units of blood were collected .10 students and 35 youth from Ashti were among the donors. Rules of social distancing were strictly followed throughout the camp. All teachers, non teaching staff and NSS Unit made efforts for success of the camp.

Outcomes :

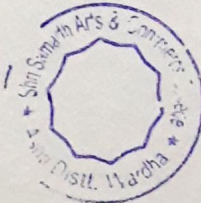
- Thirty five students and seven teachers participated in the programme through Google meet.
